All the sections and sub-sections of the British Association, ten in number, resumed at Aberdeen on Monday. There was again a large attendance. Mr Bent, in the anthropological section, read a paper to prove that study of the tombs in the Greek Islands was conducive to the knowledge of ancient and forgotten lines of commerce. Mr Wilson, American **Consul** at **Nice**, gave details of the discovery in a famous cavern at Mentone of a skeleton of a man believed to have belonged to a Paleolithic age.
